The meeting continued with approval of the agenda, following a motion from Emily Walter with a second from Cathy James.

Sharing the thought for today was Shelia Ange...attached.



No questions were presented regarding the minutes of the Executive Board held September 26, 2018. Directors had received the minutes by email and a paper copy was available for review. The minutes were approved after a motion by Shelia Ange and a second from Emily Walter.

Treasurer Cathy James passed out a copy of the financial report and went over the document with the group.

- ♦ 2019 Sue Mills Lighthouse Award -- A history of the award's creation and guidelines was given by Suzanne Hugus. All can be found on the Association website.
- ♦ 2019 Distinguished Service Award and 2019 Executive Board Award -- Shelia Ange gave details of the Association's Distinguished Service Awards and encouraging members to view the criteria and guidelines for each on the NCCEAPA website. April 1 August 1 is the period for accepting award nominations. Report is attached.
- ♦ 2019 Herter-O'Neal Scholarship report by Sally Southard. She discussed concern about the lack of awareness within the Association and a resulting low number of student applications for the scholarship. The following topics, regarding the scholarship, will be discussed at the Board of Directors at the meeting March 29. 1. Increase awareness and utilization of the scholarship details located on the NCCEAPA website. 2. Include the scholarship on the agenda at the state meeting to renew awareness.
- The NC JCEP report was available with the Secretary and will be read at the meeting March 29.
- ♦ Cathy James reported a membership total of 143. Noting due deadlines of September 1 for payment to the district and October 1 for payment to be received by the state. A discussion of a late fee on dues ended in the agreement that it could cause members not to join.

- Ad-Hoc Committee -- LaToya Lucy reported the committee has received comments from their draft guidelines for hosting a state conference. A suggestion to include a reminder of the TERSSA annual meeting rotation will be added. The final document will be found on the website as a 'working paper' resource. She noted the committee reviewed several very detailed guidelines of other professional associations for state meetings. Rather than set details into the NCCEAPA state conference guidelines, LaToya explained the document is brief and deals with basic functions and timetables intending to allow creativity and detail decision to the hosting district.
- Regarding a budget for the DSA awards, Cathy James noted the budget is \$900-figured for the money award and a plaque. The guidelines say a certificate is presented with the money award. However, at times in the past plaques had been given rather than a certificates. A change will be made to the guidelines for a 'commemorative' award allowing the DSA committee flexibility.
- A request by Jill Cofer, for training and assistance with locating Extension forms, was shared by Suzanne Hugus. Creation of an Ad-Hoc Committee or making of a forms file was discussed as ways to assist with the issue relayed by Jill.
- Funding requests to support NCCEAPA functions was updated by Cathy James. The distribution list is being updated to insure requests for annual donations to the NCCEAPA are getting to donors like commodity and Extension professional associations that have traditionally contributed. NCCEAPA has been told not to expect the awards sponsorships of \$1,000 from each NCSU and NCA&T this year, both had been longstanding annual contributions.
- Discussing salaries, members discussed support for a career ladder, merit raises, cost of living, setting compression goals or other tier raises for COSS that do not exist now. LaToya Lucy suggested members share their thoughts regarding a salary compression in a letter to Jason Painter, chairman of the Staff Senate. Send letters by email to-- jlpainte@ncsu.edu He has requested letters to become better informed and to have information to share with campus and Legislative personnel to help open discussions on salary parity for all University staff.
- Suzanne Hugus noted the upcoming deadlines and dates listed in the agenda before the meeting adjourned at 4:47 p.m., with a motion from Shelia Ange and a second by Cathy James.

- On behalf of Sheilia Griffis, Parliamentarian, Christine Barrier verified there was a quorum present.
- Members reviewed the agenda and the following changes were made: Federation Secretary was added to New Business. Shelia Ange made a motion to accept the agenda with corrections and the motion was seconded by Cathy James. The motion passed unanimously.

- Nominating Committee (Full report attached) Suzanne Hugus presented the nominating committee report. Major points covered include:
 - o 2nd Vice President, Barbara Walker retired suddenly. After attempting to recruit a replacement from the West District, Shelia Ange from the Northeast District was nominated to fill this vacancy. Shelia accepted the nomination and an online vote was generated by LaToya Lucy, President. Shelia was approved as the 2nd Vice President in August 2018.
 - Cathy James has agreed to continue to serve for 2018-19 and fulfill the two-year commitment of Treasurer.
 - Sally Southard from the North Central District has accepted the nomination for 2018-19 2nd Vice President.

- Federation Report (Full report attached) Sherry Lynn relayed that there has been nothing new since the
 forum last year and there has not been a date set for the next Federation Forum but will most likely be in

- TERSSA Christine Barrier reports that this is TERSSA's 10th year anniversary and there are 193 total TERSSA members from eight states with 84 of those members being from North Carolina. There are 35 members from NC registered to attend the National Conference in New Orleans this November.

Old Business

New Business

- Increase DSA Award Amount Suzanne Hugus made a motion from the committee to increase DSA award amounts to encourage participation. Currently the district winner receives \$50 and Suzanne has proposed this be increased to \$100. Executive Board members unanimously approved the recommendation to go before the Board of Directors for vote.
- Hurricane Florence Relief Suzanne Hugus would like to present some information regarding how we could
 participate in some type of volunteer activity to provide relief from hurricane Florence. Volunteers are being
 sought for shifts (9am-noon, noon-3pm, and 3-6pm) at the Civic Center in Jones County. Shelia Ange
 suggested this should be presented under "Announcements" during the business meeting.



- Mission Statement Suzanne Hugus has requested an official mission statement for our Association. After some discussion on appointing an ad-hoc committee and recruiting volunteers, it was decided that the Executive Board would charge the Rules & Bylaws Committee with developing a mission statement for the association. If you have any suggestions, please forward them to the bylaws committee chair.
- Federation Secretary As nominating chair, Suzanne Hugus has recruited Susan Johnson to serve as Federation representative for 2019.
- Proposed Budget Cathy James made a motion on behalf of the finance committee on the recommended proposed budget with the possible following changes depending on the outcome of the vote for increasing the monetary value of the Distinguished Service Award. In this event, the changes will be:
 - Currently under expenditures, the Distinguished Service Award shows \$500, however, it should have been \$600 (6 District Winners Plaque & \$50 monetary award). This will be changed to reflect the proposed increase for this award to a total of \$900 (6 District Winners Plaque & \$100 monetary award). \$400 from the Money Market will be added to revenue to balance this change.

Report from the North Carolina Joint Council of Extension Professionals (formerly known as North Carolina Federation of Cooperative Extension Associations)

The annual 2018 Federation Forum was held on December 7, 2018 at the Stanley County Extension Center in Albemarle.

Dr. Rich Bonanno provided an administrative update and fielded questions from participants.

Attendees participated in a café style discussion group, rotating from table to table answering predetermined questions. The results of the group discussion were shared by individuals from each table. While there are still areas that need improving, the overall outcome was favorable.

After lunch the business meeting began, Cameron Lowe, presiding. Minutes from 2017 were approved. Sherry Lynn, NCCEAPA representative serving as treasurer, provided the treasurer's report and presented the 2019 proposed budget which was approved. Association reports where provided by each Association present. The group also suggested that they meet more than one time a year.
