

NCCEAPA – Northeast District Report

Fall 2019

The NCCEAPA-NED fall meeting was held in Beaufort County on October 11, 2019 and was hosted by Sam Bowden and Ashley Latham at the N.C. Estuarium in Washington NC. Committee reports were given, and the proposed budget was passed. As the NED will be hosting the 2020 NCCEAPA State meeting and TERSA National meeting, discussion centered around our preparations. The 2019 state meeting auction was successful. The NED was the only district to bring an item to be raffled at the 2019 state meeting.
