**Administrative Professional of the Year**

The NCCEAPA-South Central District *Administrative Professional of the Year* is presented annually to an administrative professional in the district as a means of recognizing outstanding performance and contribution to the Association and Cooperative Extension. This award is presented by the North Carolina Cooperative Extension Administrative Professionals Association-South Central District.

Guidelines:

1. Nominations for the *Administrative Profession of the Year* Award may be made by any North Carolina Cooperative Extension employee or paid association member.
2. Nominees must be members of the North Carolina Cooperative Extension Administrative Professional Association for a least three (3) years and must have at least three (3) years' service with North Carolina Cooperative Extension.
3. The award will be presented annually at the fall meeting of the NCCEAPA-South Central District.
4. The administrative professional selected as a winner will not be eligible to be nominated again for a period of five (5) years.
5. Nominations must be received by the senior member of the *Administrative Professional of the Year* Committee by **July 19**. Nominees will be voted on by the members of the district with votes going to the senior member of the *Administrative Professional of the Year* Committee, who will then coordinate with committee members.
6. The winner will receive a plaque and a \$50 cash award. The award will be presented by the previous year's winner.
